

# Homework Room Rules

The homework room is a privilege provided for My Friends' Place enrollees. Each Monday-Thursday children will be provided with a quiet room in which to do homework and a proctor who is available to help with questions and grade work as it is completed. Children are responsible for knowing what homework needs to be done and completing it. My Friends' Place staff will remind children of study hall but **may not force** any child to attend, nor will they take responsibility for looking for assignments in children's bags. Children are expected to work quietly and independently while in the Homework Room. When children are finished with their assignments, they may ask the proctor to look over their work if they wish.

## Study Hall Policies:

1. Children will sit quietly and work or read in the Homework Room.
2. Children will ask for help when needed.
3. Children may have their work graded and initialed when it is completed.
4. Children who behave in a disruptive manner will be given two warnings before being asked to leave the Homework Room for the rest of the day. If a child is disruptive in a regular basis, s/he will not receive a warning before being asked to leave the room.
5. Everyday is a new day. Children who are asked to leave one day will be allowed to return and try again the next day.
